With our musical senses being constantly bombarded by crass commercialism, clones and clowns, wiggling bums and the soda-pop culture, its difficult to get a grip on anything real.

Plucking noxious weeds from the overgrown garden of rock n roll is proving to be a full-time job these days. But the day of the yellow-jackets is grinding to a halt, and relief is a relaxing six-pack road trip away.

For on the 12th & 13th of December the second annual Meredith Music Festival will take place....a celebration of the virtues of clean air, open fires and a 16 **ALL-MELBOURNE** band bill played out over two days. We have the dirty rock n roll of Hoss and the Powdermonkeys, the guitar mania of Guttersnipes, Ripe and The Mavis's, the rootsy folk-rock of the Warner Bros, the bee-bop jazz of The Naked King's Servant - those VCA virtuoso's, the acoustic tales of Rob Clarkson, Dead Salesmen, Kill Sarah and Picko, the irresistible soul/ska mix of Boxing Tostadas and Rod and many more...a delectable and diverse soundscape set at the foothills of the beautiful Brisbane Ranges.

The MMF is a totally independent festival, run by a bunch of friends who for 20 smackeroonies (or \$25 at the gate) want to offer a weekend alternative of camping, rural relaxation and a dose of Victoria's best musical talent - whatever your taste.

It's a BYO event with plenty of BBQ and camping facilities available, food stalls operating with the music to start on Saturday evening at 5.30 pm sharp.

Tickets are available at Augogo, Gaslight, and Greville St records, and all are welcome; any enquiries phone either 534.3895 or 529.4853. It is a unique once a year event that finally gets music back to its grass roots.

The shuffling beat writer William S. Burrough's, upon leaving the festival last year was heard to mutter that "Meredith is not, like alcohol or weed, a means of increased enjoyment of life, Meredith is not a kick, it is a way of life"

FACT SHEET

- * Meredith is 90 kms due West of Melbourne, Melways reference 425 C5, or 409 C3. The easiest way from Melbourne is via Geelong, which takes around 90 minutes.
- * The Festival is over two days, the 12th and 13th of December, 1992. Gates open 2.30pm on Saturday, parking and camping are free, BYO tent etc.
- * Bands start 5.30pm Saturday, and play until the wee small hours - there is **NO CURFEW**, no noise restrictions. There are 16 bands; the bill starts again Sunday morning.
- * The site is a natural amphitheatre.
- * Tickets are \$20 pre-sold, or \$25 at the gate.
- * BYO alcohol, **NO GLASS!!** The Royal Hotel is 10 mins from the site. BBQ facilities will be available, there will also be food stalls operating.
- * People are expected from all over Victoria especially Melbourne, Geelong, The West Coast, Ballarat, Bendigo, Warrnambool - everywhere!!
- * The Festival is non-profit, any profit will be poured into next years Festival.
- * This is the Festival's second year, last year attracting 300 people, this year, organizers expect to double that, and then some.
- * Organised by friends of good music.
